1. Introduction

- 1.1 The Website of EMS Brokers is operated by FXNET Limited. FXNET Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'FxNet', the 'Company', the 'Firm', 'us', 'our') is a Cypriot Investment Firm (CIF) which is authorized and regulated by the Cyprus Securities and Exchange Commission ("CySEC"), under license number 182/12, incorporated and registered under the laws of the Republic of Cyprus (Certificate of Incorporation No. 300624), registered office at 4 Theklas Lysiotti St, Harmony House, Office 31, 3rd floor, 3030 Limassol, Cyprus.
- 1.2 The Company is authorized and regulated as a Cyprus Investment Firm (CIF) to offer certain Investment and Ancillary Services and Activities under the Provisions of the Investment Services, the Exercise of Investment Activities, the Operation of Regulated Markets and Other Related Matters Law of 2017, Law 87(I)/2017.
- 1.3 This Cookies Policy should be read together with the Privacy Policy, which provides further information on how personal data is processed.
- 1.4 This Cookies Policy explains how FXNET Limited (the "Company") uses cookies and similar technologies when users access the Company's Website.

2. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that are stored on a user's device (computer, tablet or mobile device) when a website is accessed. Cookies allow the website to recognize a user's device and store certain information about preferences or past actions.

Cookies do not damage devices, do not contain executable code, and cannot be used to distribute malware or viruses.

3. Legal basis for the use of cookies

The Company uses cookies in accordance with:

- Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (GDPR); and
- the ePrivacy Directive (2002/58/EC), as implemented in Cyprus.

Cookies are used on the following legal bases:

- Strictly necessary cookies are processed on the basis of legitimate interest, as they are essential for the operation and security of the Website.
- Non-essential cookies (including performance, analytics, functionality and targeting cookies) are used only with the user's prior consent, which may be withdrawn at any time.

4. Categories of cookies used

- 4.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

These cookies are essential for the operation of the Website and enable core functionalities such as security, network management and accessibility. Without these cookies, the Website cannot function properly.

Strictly necessary cookies do not require user consent.

4.2 Performance and Analytics Cookies

These cookies collect aggregated and anonymous information about how users interact with the Website (e.g. pages visited, traffic sources, time spent on pages). The information is used to improve Website performance and user experience.

Analytics cookies are used only with the user's consent.

4.3 Functionality Cookies

Functionality cookies allow the Website to remember choices made by users (such as language preferences or region) and provide enhanced, more personalized features.

These cookies may be set by the Company or by third-party service providers and are used only with the user's consent.

4.4 Targeting and Advertising Cookies

Targeting cookies may be used to deliver content or advertisements that are relevant to a user's interests. These cookies track browsing activity across websites and are typically placed by third-party advertising networks.

The Company uses targeting cookies only with the user's explicit consent.

5. First-party and third-party cookies

- **First-party cookies** are set by the Company and are used primarily for security, authentication and core Website functionality.
- **Third-party cookies** are set by external service providers (such as analytics or customer-support providers) and are subject to the privacy policies of those third parties.

The Company does not control third-party cookies and encourages users to review the relevant third-party privacy and cookies policies.

6. Session and persistent cookies

- **Session cookies** are temporary cookies that expire when the browser is closed.
- **Persistent cookies** remain stored on the user's device for a defined period or until deleted and are used to remember preferences across visits.

7. Managing cookie preferences

Users may manage or withdraw their cookie preferences at any time through:

- the cookie consent management tool available on the Website; and/or
- browser settings, which allow users to block or delete cookies.

Please note that disabling strictly necessary cookies may affect the functionality and security of the Website.
